

What are “Flags”?

The purpose of a ‘flag’ in PeopleSoft Student Administration is to track students in the system and give them permissions for registration. The Education Support Center gives a flag to students in PeopleSoft as described:

01 flag - Entered after receiving an Application for Teacher Education.

This flag is used to pull the student into Tk20 in order to track and update admission requirements. This flag enables the student to register* for any classes that require application to teacher education.

02 flag - Entered after a student is fully accepted into Teacher Education.

This flag enables the student to register* for any classes that require admission/acceptance to teacher education.

03 flag - Given when the student has met all requirements for student teaching.

This flag enables the student to register* for any classes that require having met all requirements for student teaching.

*Overrides should not be given to students to take courses that require admission into Teacher Education. Instead, students should file an appeal with their program. The ESC will give a temporary flag to allow them to register upon receipt of an appeal form with approval from the program.
