
## Mapping the Integral Epistemological Quadrants via the Tools of the Unified Theory

#### The Interior Human Phenomenological View




(The unique subjective-self-soul-spirit view from within)

#### The Exterior Object Level




(The scientific analysis of patterns of behavior)

(Intersubjective justification systems for sense and meaning making and coordinating action)


#### The Exterior Holistic Developmental Systems View
