CHILDIST DISCOMFORT WITH PEDAGOGY: AREN'T WE SCHOOLING TOWARDS INTERGENERATIONAL INJUSTICE?

The speaker reflects on the role of schooling and pedagogy in ensuring intergenerational climate justice as a response to contemporary children and youth's climate activism. The goal driving rapid global developments in the schooling sector is not intergenerational sustainability. On the contrary, *misopedy* (adultism) seems foundational to accelerated industrial growth, requiring standardized schooling to produce 'future human capital'. Therefore, the question arises: Aren't we schooling towards intergenerational injustice?
